- People listed who accept an invitation to work with a healthcare organisation or event organiser are independent and are not acting on behalf of AvMA. AvMA is not responsible for the quality of work carried out or any dispute that arises.
- Any arrangements made between the healthcare organisations, conference organisers or training organisations and the person listed is a matter for them. This includes any payments made. AvMA provides the listings free of charge.
- AvMA will provide an online contact form which will deliver enquiries to the people listed without them having to make their email address public. This will mean AvMA keeps a record of enquiries made through its site.
